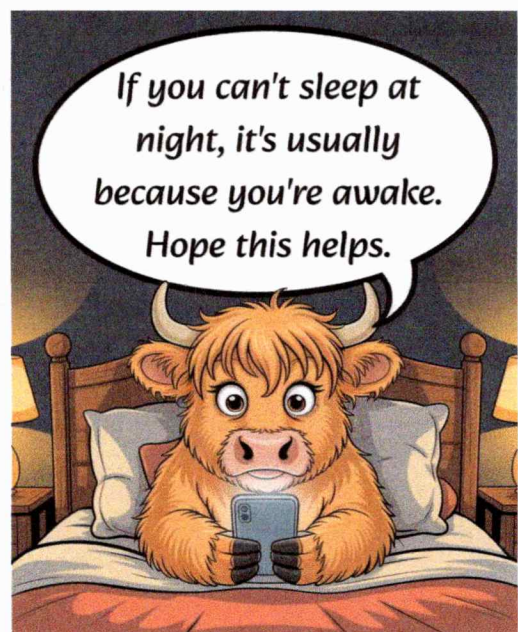

The Covington Outreach Association and Meijer Partner Up to Fight Hunger

One in eight Americans face food insecurity nationwide and our community continues to feel its impact*. More and more members of our community are turning to us for help in ensuring they know where their next meal will come from. The Covington Outreach Association has seen a continued demand in the last year and the resulting economic impact of our nation continues to bring great need and challenges to our community.

In response, we're pleased to announce that the COA has joined forces with the Meijer Simply Give hunger relief program during this difficult time to help fill that void for our local families.
