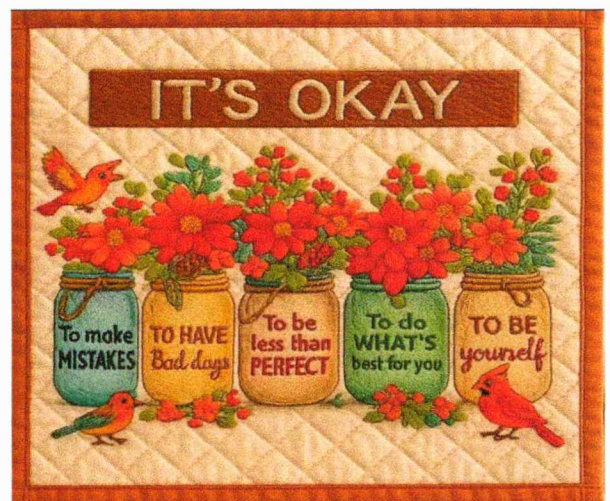

Looking Ahead

As we move into and through Advent, Christmas and Epiphany, we hear many familiar stories from scripture.
