### Amish Blueberry Lemon Muffins



#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 3 cups flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup softened butter
- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 4 eggs
- 2 1 /2 tablespoons lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons grated lemon zest
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 cup buttermilk
- 2 cups blueberries

#### glaze

- 1 1 /2 cups powdered sugar
- 3 tablespoons lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon lemon zest

#### INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat the oven to 350°F.

Lightly greased muffin tins or line tins with cupcake papers.

In a large mixing bowl, combine the flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt.

Set aside. In a medium mixing bowl, cream the butter and sugar until thoroughly blended.

Beat in the eggs, one egg at a time. Add lemon juice, lemon zest, and vanilla until smooth in consistency.

Beat in flour mixture and buttermilk, alternating dry ingredients with buttermilk, adding about ½ each time.

The mixture should be smooth and creamy.

Fold in the blueberries and mix until the blueberries are even distributed throughout the batter. Pour the batter into the muffin tins, filling the tins about half full. Bake until the muffin tops are golden, 20-25 minutes.

Allow to cool about 5 minutes. In a small mixing bowl, combine the sugar, lemon juice, and lemon zest until a smooth consistency is achieved.

#### **Brethren Disaster Ministry Updates**

Fundraising Data – August was fundraising month for S. Ohio/KY BDM. Thank you to all who had a part in this! The Ice Cream Social raised \$8,850. The Golf Scramble that was held with Camping & Retreat Ministries, raised \$3,220 for each. The Darke County Fair parking at Orthopedic Associates raised \$2,580. The fundraising total was \$14,650. In the past year about \$60,000 was used to support BDM's work with rebuilding and CWS kits. We appreciate the support of the S. Ohio/KY District!

Rebuilding Opportunities - October 8-14 is our next scheduled week to work on tornado recovery in Dawson Springs, KY. There are openings for two volunteers. The November 5-11 crew will go to eastern Kentucky, with work in Jackson, repairing homes that were damaged by flooding. Volunteers of all skill levels are welcome. CWS Bucket Assembly - Plan to come on Thursday, Oct. 19 at 6:30 PM, for the assembly of 528 Cleanup Buckets for Church World Service (CWS). It will be at Bullen Ultrasonics, 1301 Miller Williams Rd., Eaton. Workers will put cleaning supplies in the buckets, put on the lids, and then stack them on pallets. These will be shipped to the Brethren Service Center and then distributed to flood survivors.
