**Jane & Terry Lavy & Family** - Jane is undergoing chemo. Jane & Terry are thankful for your continued prayers.

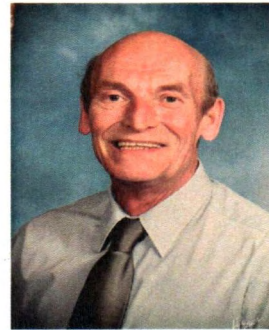

This team has returned. They were replaced by other CDS volunteers, which includes one from S. Ohio.

During the Church Board meeting on June 15th, the members gave an enthusiastic thank you to those who worked on updating the Church Directory.

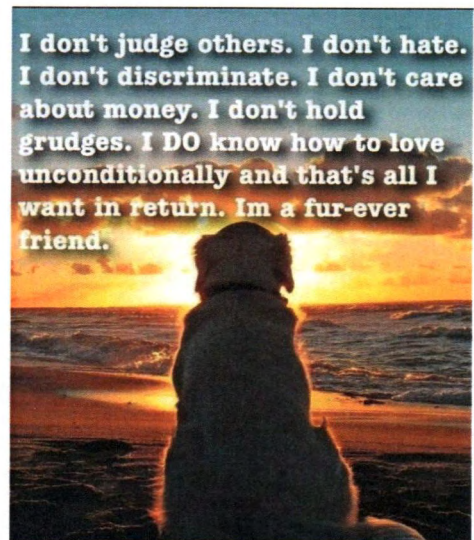
